SPRING MEANS STUDENT GRANT AWARDS

Spring means many things to each of us: the coming of warm weather, Easter, colorful young flowers, perhaps graduation plans and traveling. For AAUW Glendale members it also means our annual Student Grants Award Meeting, the highlights of the individuals receiving the awards and the speaker who will be talking to us members and our additional audience of awardees, their counselors and guests.

Our speaker is Dr. Carolyn Heldman who will present how the modern expressions in media limit women's ambition and professionalism. She earned her Ph.D. in Political Science from Rutgers University, and is currently an Assistant Professor at Occidental College in Los Angeles. She has published in the top journals in her field, and has co-authored *Rethinking Madame President: Are we Ready for a Woman in the White House...* She specializes in the presidency, media, gender, and race in the American context. Prior to teaching at Occidental College, Professor Heldman taught at Whittier College, Fairfield University, and Rutgers University.

Dr. Heldman will present her thoughts about women's position in a society where objectivity is the most persuasive force shaping cultural norms. The collective message that our young women and men overwhelmingly receive is that a woman's value and power lie in her youth, beauty, and sexuality, and not in her capacity as a leader. While women have made great strides in leadership over the past few decades, the United States is still 90th in the world for women in national legislatures, woman hold only 3% of clout positions in mainstream media
