SPEAKER FOCUS: WOMEN IN GOVERNMENT

The speaker for our last AAUW branch meeting of the 2014-15 year will be **Yasmin K. Beers**, who is currently the Assistant City Manager for the City of Glendale. She will speak about the responsibilities of the City Manager's office, their achievements, and challenges. Yasmin serves as the Chief Operating Officer overseeing approximately 1,500 employees serving in Police, Fire, Public Works, Parks, Library Arts and Culture to name a few, including the Glendale Water and Power. She is responsible for City-wide budget oversight, employee relations, the Capital Improvement Program, policy management, and performs as an Administrative Hearing officer for the City. In 2011, the Glendale Chamber of Commerce recognized Yasmin as Woman of the Year.

Yasmin has lived in Glendale since 1985 and began her career with the City of Glendale in 1987 as a part-time employee in the Library Department while in high school and college. She is married and has 2 children.

We look forward to hearing Ms. Beers speak about her experiences in the City Manager's office.
