Dr. Troy Davis, a professor and counsellor from Glendale College to speak on Requirements for Admissions and Transfers to Universities at the May 14th AAUW Glendale Student Grant Event.

A former EOP student, Dr. Troy Davis has a B.A. degree in Psychology, as well as a Master's of Science degree in Educational Psychology from California State University, Long Beach. Also holds a Master's and doctoral degree in Clinical Psychology with an emphasis in Multicultural Cultural Community Psychology, from Alliant International University, California School of Professional Psychology.

He was an EOP Counselor for UC Santa Barbara for three years (1994-1997) and left to pursue a career at Glendale College (1997-Present). He has been teaching and counseling students at Glendale College for eighteen years in the areas of Athletics and International Counseling, as well as Adjunct Instruction of Psychology courses for six years. Within the last four years of his works within Clinical Psychology, he has expanded his professional responsibilities to community mental health environments, where he has been staffed as a Professional Psychologist at Native American Indian Involvement, Gateways Psychiatric Hospital, and Faithful Central Baptist Church. Lastly, Dr. Davis has served in the Glendale College Guild Union as Public Information Officer and he continues to develop the skills of future counselors by coordinating the Graduate Student Internship Program.
