Women in Politics



<u>Phlunte' Riddle</u> is an educator, businesswoman, public safety executive, community leader and resident of Pasadena. She broke barriers and honed her leadership skills in the nearly 29 years she spent rising through the ranks of the Pasadena Police Department. She was the first woman to be permanently assigned as a gang/street narcotics officer, the first African American female sergeant and lieutenant. As a lieutenant, she was the Public Information Officer and Adjutant to the Chief of Police. She currently serves as a commissioner for the Pasadena Center Operating Company Board, which oversees the management of the Pasadena Convention Center. She has been an active member of the UN Association-Pasadena Chapter and a former board member of Foothill Family Services. She is a strong advocate on women's issues.

Ms. Riddle received her doctorate degree specializing in psychology from Phillips Graduate Institute. She holds an MA degree in Organizational Leadership from Woodbury University and a BS degree in Public Administration from the University of LaVerne. She is also a graduate from the FBI National Academy in Quantico, Virginia. She has been married for 36 years and has three adult sons.

She will be speaking on "Women in Politics".

President's Message


